



INSTRUCTIONS TO CUSTOMER

- 1. DO read this manual before using your drill.
- 2. DO be sure the voltage of the power supply agress with the data on the nameplate.
- 3. DO be sure the switch is in OFF position before connecting drill to the power supply.
- 4. DO be sure working area is clean.
- 5. DO keep away children from working area and not allow them to operate drill.
- 6. DO disconnect your drill from the power supply, when not in use, when cleaning, changing bits, attachments, carbon brushes or doing maintenance.
- 7. DO insert drill bit in the chuck the full length of the jaws.
- 8. DO use Towa's replacement parts only.
- 9. DO disconnect drill from the power supply and store in a clean dry place beyond the reach of children.
- 10. DO use light oill on drill bits to prevent overheating when drilling metals.
- 11. DO make small pilot hole when working in metals.
- 12. DO NOT force tool, allow drill to perform as it was designed.
- 13. DO NOT carry drill by power cord.
- 14. DO NOT change direction while drill is running.
- 15. DO NOT carry drill with the switch in ON position.
- 16. DO NOT keep drill running when not in use.







SWITCH

Depress trigger switch to start drilling and release switch to stop.

The lock button may be engaged while trigger is depressed.

This locking mechanism may be easily released by depressing trigger switch again.



Insert the chuck key in the chuck using the three holes on the chuck in turn and turn the key counter-clockwise to wide open chuck jaws.

Insert a drill bit and close the chuck jaws by turning the key in a clockwise direction.


DRILLING IN WOOD


To prevent ugly splits around the drilled hole on the reverse side of lumber, place a scrap lumber beneath the material to be drilled.


DRILLING IN METAL


Metals such as steel sheets, brass and aluminum sheets, stainless steel, pipe may also be drilled.

Before drilling, mark the point to be drilled with a nail or a punch.























MOUNTING OF DISC PAPER

Your drill may be converted to disc sander by mounting special attachment (optional).

- 1. Place sanding shaft in the chuck.
- 2. Next, mount in order of pad, disc paper and clamp nut.

Efficient for rust removing, surface finishing of lumber and pre-finishing for painting.

Use coarse grit sandpaper for removing rust and paint, and fine grit paper for wood board finishing.


MOUNTING OF WOOL BONNET

Install a wool bonnet as illustrated to the right. Put wool bonnet over sanding pad and fasten strings.

OSE AS A POLISHER for best finishing of furniture, window panes, automobiles, etc.
